

The Transformational Model



The program cycle is framed in a transformation model focusing on seven thematic areas. Within this model, projects will be developed in line with the strategic results framework.

Food Security and Sustainable Livelihood

We aim to reduce community vulnerability to effects of food and livelihood insecurity demonstrated through increased income for vulnerable households and internally displaced people and reduced food insecurity among the vulnerable households and IDPs.

The core actions, include cash transfer targeting IDPs and vulnerable and very low-income households; entrepreneurship skills development; monitoring and developing capacity of local market and advocating for



inclusive access to fair markets; promoting climate-smart agricultural practices and technologies; enhancing household food production, diversification and storage; and providing emergency food assistance.

Child Protection

We aim to enhance fulfilment and protection of children's rights and equal access to justice and opportunities demonstrated through increased protection of children from violence, abuse, exploitation, and neglect. The core actions include providing prevention, protection, and response/ support services and protection and response interventions, together with promoting child rights governance.



Inclusive and Quality Education for All

We aim to enhance access to auality education for vulnerable children demonstrated through increased children's access to quality pre-school and formal primary education. The core actions include providing capacity building for children, adolescents and parents and caregivers; promoting inclusive primary school enrollment; providing educational support for children and schools; enhancing school management; school infrastructural development/rehabilitation; awareness creation; strengthening community education committees; and implementing teacher trainings.



Youth Empowerment and Skills Development



We aim to enhance youth wellbeing and contribution to social-economic change and

development in their communities demonstrated through inclusive and equitable youth economic development and increased youth civic participation in local governance and decision-making Providing skills development and mentorship.

The core actions include Providing skills development and mentorship; enhancing decent employment for youth (entrepreneurship skills development and TVET); and strengthening civic space for youth participation, inclusion, voicing, and leadership.



Climate Change and Environmental Sustainability

We aim to strengthen institutional capacity to mitigate and respond to disaster and climate change effects demonstrated through increased community and household resilience to the impacts of climate change and environmental degradation. The core actions include community capacity building; providing disaster recovery and rehabilitation services;



promoting environmental protection and conservation; strengthening climate-smart technologies; and participation in early warning systems strengthening.

Good Governance

We aim to strengthen institutional capacity to mitigate and respond to disaster and climate change effects demonstrated through empowered and inclusive communities benefiting from responsive governance systems that uphold human rights, ensure equitable access to public services, and safeguard civic and political freedoms. The core actions include strengthening inclusive participation and leadership; strengthening participatory social accountability monitoring;



promoting CSO-led public policy engendering and public policy monitoring and advocacy; and promoting inclusive peacebuilding and democratic engagement processes.

Integrated Community Health, Nutrition, and WASH

We aim to reduce mobility and mortality rates in vulnerable and conflict-affected communities, particularly children and women and the most-at-risk people demonstrated through increased access to access to health care, nutrition and water, sanitation and hygiene_services for vulnerable households, mainly children and women and the marginalized.

The core actions include enhancing the institutional capacity of health facilities; developing and



implementing health counselling services; developing and implementing school health programs; implementing Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program; developing and implementing nutrition counseling services; promoting mass screening, referral and vaccination; developing and investing in safe water sources; and providing sanitation facilities and hygiene promotion and commodities.

Research

YOVENCO will invest in research, analysis, and knowledge sharing across all program sectors to inform advocacy, decision-making, learning and continuous improvement.
